- **Foster Care Training/Tier System**
 - This system is used at CPS to assess the level of need of a child, and assign a foster care provider who has received training to deal with the need to that individual child. Brianna Robbins/Pat Larson
 - Is current level of required training adequate?
 - Bob Nickel (CDRC) currently working on a grant related to creating an on-line course for caregivers of SEN.
- **CPS Personal Care Nurse Program**
 - Personal Care Nurses can assess babies in the hospital/creates safe care plans for infants going to foster care. Needs to be referred by Brianna Robbins.
 - Sharay Baker a CPS Personal Care Nurse in Lane County
- **Medical Passports/Safe Care Plans**
 - Paper file (Kelli A. has been piloting use of a paper folder, others have been used in CPS in past).
 - Ruth Stroemple’s model of training/safe care plans
 - World Health Organization website (Randy Phelps has information). Provides an on-line forum to input child/family health information. Whoever has custody of child would hold the password.
 - Bob Nickel has information on a “credit card” electronic record system for accessing child medical records.
- **ECCARES**
 - Federal Law requires any child under the age of 3 with founded abuse/neglect automatic referral to Early Intervention (ECCARES) for developmental screening.
 - Screening is 1x..many delays may not present for some time...recommend monitoring (repeated screening) every 6 months for children under age 3.
- **SEN Clinic**
 - Randy Phelps is interested in starting a SEN clinic at CDRC.
 - Would like to have professionals/parents refer to him as needed. If questions/concerns arise that they would like support with.
- **Resource Bank related to SEN for caregivers**
 - Inform all parents/caregivers at hospital...magnets, follow-up phone call?
 - House Resource Bank at SEN Clinic
 - Some organization (CDRC or Public Health) take responsibility for maintaining on-line website
