

FEAT Prenatal Screening Workgroup Meeting Minutes, February 21, 2008

 - i. **Referral algorithm:**
 1. We need to consult the following groups about their current practices and how best to refer clients for treatment or support:
 - a. Willamette Family Treatment (Susie Dey)
 - b. Relief Nursery (Gretchen Dubie)
 - c. FEAT Family Advocate (Heather)
 - d. Serenity Lane (doesn't serve pregnant women, Peter Asmeth)
 - e. Emergence (call Susie Dey to find out who to talk to)
 - f. DHS
 2. We need to consult the following groups about how they currently make referrals, what resources are most effective
 - a. Peacehealth (Desiree and Jill)
 - b. McKenzie Willamette (Kay Yanit)
 3. Questions to ask include:
 - a. What population do you serve?
 - b. Do you provide outpatient, inpatient treatment and/or home visiting services?
 - c. Do you serve pregnant women?
 - d. Do you take and/or require private insurance?
 - e. Who is the contact person for referring a patient for your services?
 - f. What is the process for making a referral?
 - g. For those who refer: Where/how do you currently make referrals?
 4. Kris will begin to make these contacts and interview referral sources.
